

IMPORTANT NOTICE: IMPLEMENTATION OF PER CREDIT FEES FOR STUDENTS EXCEEDING THE MINIMUM STUDY PERIOD FOR SEMESTER 2 SESSION 2024/2025

We would like to inform students that are in Semester 2 Session 2024/2025, who exceed the minimum study period will be charged fees on a per-credit basis. Please refer to UNIMAS Bachelor's Degree Academic Regulations in Article 9 regarding the Study Period.

The per-credit fee structure for students who exceed the minimum study period is as follows:

Programme	Minimum Study Period Semesters Exceeding Minimu		
3 years	6 semesters	Semester 7 to 12	
3 1/2 years	7 semesters	Semester 8 to 14	
4 years	8 semesters	Semester 9 to 14	

The implementation of the per-credit fee payment method for students who exceed the minimum study period is as follows:

1. Tuition fees are based on the per-credit fee rate according to the total credits taken in that semester. The rates are listed in the following table:

- 2. Recurring fees will be charged to all students registered with UNIMAS according to their semester.
- 3. Students who repeat courses after the minimum study period will be exempted from repeat course fees.
- 4. Registration in the Intersession will be charged according to the Per Credit Fee rate. Recurring fees will not be charged for Intersession registration.
- 5. The implementation of the Per Credit Fee does not apply to students from the Doctor of Medicine Program.

Students who have exceeded the minimum study period are required to apply for the Per Credit Fee through the InAFS system. Failure to apply through InAFS will result in students being unable to register for courses.
